Our two PAGE High School Interns for 2016 will spend seven summer weeks in June-July working with a team of Duke University undergraduates at the PAGE site: Hot Springs Elementary School. High School Interns serve as role models and mentors for girls in rising grades 6-9. Our High School Interns also receive mentoring from a successful PAGE college intern (a Duke student) to help with creating college pathways.

The opportunities enjoyed by our High School Interns include:

- ❖ One-to-one support with the college search and application process
- ❖ A chance to learn about digital literacy through advanced training
- ❖ Leadership opportunities
- ❖ One week on a college campus

Benefits include:

- ✚ Payment of \$1,000 (payable in two payments of \$500 and dependent upon responsible attendance and committed work)

- ✚ School bus transportation to/from the PAGE site
